Institute for Signal and Information Processing (ISIP) is looking for three undergraduate students who can work for 15 to 20 hours per week starting immediately for a speech research project. The job will last through Summer '00, with the possibility of longer term employment for outstanding workers. The payment rate is \$6.50/hr. The location of the job is the ISIP Demo Room, located in Room 414 in the Simrall Engineering Building.

This job involves validating a speech database — listening to a speech file and typing what was spoken. The material consists of over 200 hours of telephone conversations collected over standard long distance telephone lines. No special computer skills are required, other than the ability to point and click.

We seek hard-working, organized and methodical individuals. Flexible hours are not an option — you will need to stick to your schedule on a weekly basis due to laboratory space constraints.
