outstanding workers. The payment rate is \$6.50/hr. The location of the job is the ISIP Demo Room, located in Room 414 on the fourth floor of the Simrall Engineering Building.

This job involves validating a speech database — listening to a speech file and adjusting boundaries between speech and non-speech. The material consists of over 250 hours of telephone conversations collected over standard long distance telephone lines. No special computer skills are required, other than the ability to point and click.

We seek hard-working, organized and methodical individuals. Flexible hours are not an option — you will need to stick to your schedule on a weekly basis due to laboratory space constraints.
